Year 5 Trip to The Project

We are excited to announce that during January, Year 5 will be taking a trip to The Project in Poole to experience rock climbing and parkour. Listed below are the dates of when your child's class will be attending.

This will allow the children to explore our topic "Five go Mountaineering" and bring it to life! We are therefore asking for a voluntary contribution of £13.00 per child to cover the costs. This includes one hour of rock climbing with specialist instructors, one hour of Parkour with specialist instructors along with transport to and from the venue. We are very aware of the current cost of living crisis and have heavily subsidised this trip to match the same price as last year, with thanks to the Physical Education team and PATCH.

Children will need to wear sport type clothes and trainers on the day. This can be their school P.E kit. As we are using our own transport, 5T children may arrive back slightly later than the 3.10pm finish due to the unforeseeable issue of traffic. However, it will be no later than 3.30pm.
