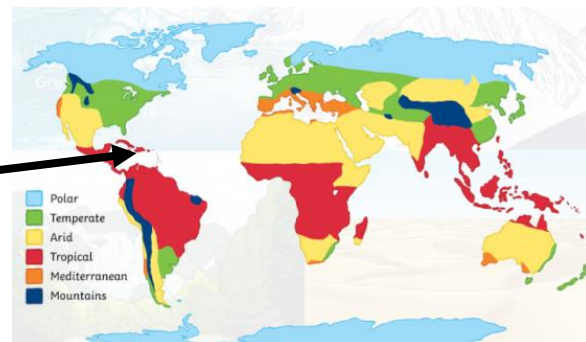


These are the 8 points on a compass
