

















The world is made up of different climate zones.

The Caribbean is in the Tropical zone



Polar climate zones are located at the Earth's poles, have freezing temperatures, long cold winters and not much precipitation.

<u>Key Vocab</u>

Equator - an imaginary line going across the centre of the world **precipitation** - rain, snow, sleet, or hail that falls to or condenses on the ground: **qlacier** - a large body of thick ice
