<u>Easter Treats Day — Poor Weather Plan</u>

On Wednesday 27th March, we are due to have our annual Easter Treats Day. As part of this day, you will be aware that there is an Easter bonnet parade, where we walk from Canford Heath Junior School parade around Learoyd Road and into Nettleton Close; through the alley and left onto Bader Road. Then carry on walking and turn right into Dundas Road and then back on to Bader Road where the children will turn right and head for Adastral Road. Right at Adastral Road and then walking down the hill back into Learoyd Road and returning to school. However, having seen the weather forecast for Wednesday, we felt it important to make you aware of our poor weather plan:

- On the day, if the weather is deemed too poor for the parade to take place (the current forecast is for rain and heavy winds), then we will send a text by 8:15am letting you know that the poor weather plan has been activated.
- This means that you will be invited into school for a 15-minute year group parade and photo <u>opportunity</u> in the school hall (see below for timings).
- If you have kindly volunteered to help us with our parade, <u>you will no longer be required</u>, but thank you so much for your offer as these types of events simply cannot happen without you.
- The activities that were going to take place at Haymoor Junior School will still take place at CHJS instead and the planned morning activities will be unaffected.
- We will still give out prizes and Easter gifts to the children for taking part in the day, which have been kindly donated by the PATCH.
- The exhibition of artwork will still proceed as planned (from 3:15pm in the school hall).
