We are delighted to advise you that, due to last year's Cookery Club being extremely popular, we have decided to continue to run Cookery club for the academic year 25/26. Cookery Club will run on a Thursday and will commence **Thursday 11th September 2025** respectively.

This letter was sent out in the summer term, however, since then, we have unfortunately had to increase the cost of the club due to increased costs to the school. The new price for the club will be £24 for 6 weeks which is £4 a session. One of the half terms will be 5 weeks which will cost £20 for the 5 weeks.

If you would like your child to participate, please complete the form via this link <https://forms.office.com/e/d8Vkf7qXdg?origin=lprLink> as soon as possible in order for us to put together a list of children and allocate spaces. Upon receipt of your child's slip, another letter will be issued with the dates of your child's sessions and details of how to pay on the school gateway.

The club is limited to 30 children per half term and places will be issued on a first come, first served basis. When all places for the upcoming term are filled, children will be placed a list for the following term's clubs, and confirmation/payment request letters will be sent out a few weeks before the new term starts.

If your child successfully gains a place, it is essential that you also return the slip regarding medical conditions/allergies and your emergency contact number to the Cookery Club leaders via the office. Offered places will be held for one week to allow payment to be made, before a place is withdrawn and offered to the next hopeful child.

The sessions will run from 3.10pm to 4.15pm. **Please note the children will need to bring a container to each session, so that they can take their food home with them.**

Also, although nuts are not incorporated into the recipes, we cannot guarantee that the ingredients have been sourced from a nut free factory.
