

Topic

Maths

In maths, we will be starting off with addition and subtraction. We will look at doing this mentally as well as using formal written methods to add and subtract up to four-digit numbers. Once secure, they will look at money and apply the formal methods. Learning about how to solve problems that involve these areas of maths, will also be a focus this half term.

As always we will continue to work on times tables throughout every week in our lessons.

Reading

This half term, we will be basing our reading lessons around a book called *The Christmasaurus and the Winter Witch* by Tom Fletcher. It is a book full of magic and wonder and where the fate of Christmas hangs in the balance.

Children are expected to read at home at least **4 times a week for 20 minutes** and get their reading records signed. This greatly helps your child's reading development and also supports progress with their writing too.
