

## Key Vocabulary

**Conflict** - a serious disagreement or argument, typically a long one.

**Shelter** - a place giving temporary protection from bad weather or danger


**Deprived** - suffering a severe and damaging lack of basic materials (like food)

**Allied** - joined by or relating to members of an alliance.

**Axis** - the alliance of Nazi Germany, Italy, and Japan

**Rationing** - allow each person to have only a fixed amount of a something s like food.

**Propaganda** - information, especially of a biased or misleading nature, used to promote a political cause




The Axis powers were opposed by (against) the Allied Powers in World War II.
