DAY REHEARSAL ARRANGEMENTS – Wednesday 8th July 2026

The rehearsal will take place at the Lighthouse during the school day.

Morning drop off	<p>Please could you drop your child at the <u>LIGHTHOUSE</u> between 8.10am and 9am.</p> <p>A more detailed plan will follow once I have completed a health and safety risk assessment with the council.</p>
Return to school	<p>Your child will be transported <u>BACK TO SCHOOL</u> after the rehearsals and will be ready <u>AT SCHOOL</u> for normal end of day collection.</p> <p>This transport of both school minibus and coaches will be of no cost to yourself, as it is kindly being paid for by the Trust.</p>
Lunch	<p>Each child will need a packed lunch, two bottles of water (no fizzy drinks) and some healthy snacks. Please do not order any hot school meals on this day, but send your child in with a packed lunch instead. If your child is entitled to a Free School meal, the school will convert the order to a packed lunch.</p>
Entertainment	<p>The children may also like to bring a book, colouring or some form of non-electrical entertainment for when they are waiting to rehearse.</p>
Phones	<p>The children will be asked to hand their phones into staff on arrival and these will be given back to them at the end of the day.</p>
Dress code	<p>Normal school uniform (information attached).</p>
Medication	<p>Normal medication will be taken to the event with the first aider. If you have any new medication please make sure it is handed to a teacher or the lead first aider on the day.</p>



EVENING CONCERT ARRANGEMENTS – Wednesday 8th July 2026

Arrival at the concert	<p><u>Children in the concert need to return to the Lighthouse for 5.45pm.</u> The children are to go straight to the main concert hall and sit down on the stage. Parents will be asked to remain in the foyers until 6.10pm A registration point and member of staff will be allocated to every class, please report to them on arrival. (This information will be shared with you nearer the time)</p> <p>To avoid congestion, please park away from the Lighthouse and walk your child to the main doors. Parking will be extremely busy.</p>
Concert times	<p><u>The concert will start at 6.30pm,</u> and will last for approximately one hour and fifteen minutes. The bar and café will be open for refreshments before and after the concert.</p>
Tickets	<p>Tickets will cost £9.25 per person and will be on sale from 10am on Wednesday 25th March 2026 Please note that the Lighthouse charges will include a £2 per ticket levy, a 10% box office fee and a debit card transaction fee.</p> <p>Tickets can be purchased from the Lighthouse Box Office, over the telephone or from www.lighthousepoole.co.uk</p> <p>Please bring all your family and friends, so we have a full house to show our support to the children. The last concert was a sell out within 24 hours!</p>
Dress Code:	Smart school Uniform (information attached).
Medication:	Please inform Mrs Turner of any medical needs <u>which the school are not already aware of</u> before concert day. There will be a school first aider on site at all times.
Phones:	The children are not allowed phones with them in the evening
Programme:	A glossy programme will be on sale during the evening. This will make a memorable souvenir.
Raffle:	A raffle will take place on the night to raise funds for the music department.
Collecting your child after the concert:	<p>At the end of the concert, we will ask that parents in the audience remain seated. The children will be escorted to their exit points by our members of staff. Once all the children are safely at the exit points, I will then ask the parents to leave the theatre, collecting their children route.</p> <p>Parents who are not attending the concert, but are collecting their child after the concert, should follow the exit maps on the walls in the Lighthouse to locate their collection point.</p>
