Cookery Club



We are delighted to advise you that, due to last year's club being extremely popular, we have decided to run 2 cookery clubs! Cookery Club 1 will be on Mondays and Cookery Club 2 will be on Tuesdays and they will commence Monday 12th September and Tuesday 13th September respectively.

The cost of the club will be £15.00 for the 6 weeks, and will cover the cost of all the ingredients.

We will run both clubs throughout the year, on a rolling, 6-week programme. If you would like your child to participate, please log on to the schoolgateway, register your consent for this club and make the payment. You can select either Monday OR Tuesday and only ONE of the 6-week blocks. Each club is limited to 15 children at a time and are on a first come basis and there are currently 4 blocks available on the gateway.

So that everyone has an equal opportunity to sign up to one of the clubs, we are opening the sessions up for the whole autumn term, so 60 children in total will be able to attend. The schoolgateway will be open for you to book your child's place on one of the 6-week sessions from 5pm tomorrow. If you do not have access to the gateway, please ensure you either register before 5pm or contact the school office. If your child has recently joined us in year 3 and they have an older sibling already in the Junior School, you may need to log out of the schoolgateway app, and log back in again in order to see your year 3 child's details.

The gateway will go 'live' on Wednesday 7th September 2022 at 5pm.

If your child successfully gains a place, it is essential that you also return the slip regarding medical conditions/allergies and your emergency contact number to the Cookery Club leaders via the office.

If your child is in Year 3 and you have not yet registered for the school gateway, please see the attached letter on how to register or return the slip below by Friday 9th September. If your child is unable to attend on a particular day due to prior commitments (e.g. school orchestra, external swimming lessons) please indicate this on the reply slip, otherwise it is assumed that either of the days is acceptable.

If all the places are taken when you log in, please note that we will be doing the same for the Spring term 2023 later on.

The sessions will run from 3.10pm to 4.15pm. **Please note the children will need to bring a container to each session, so that they can take their food home with them.** Children might not bring food home every week as some recipes may need a double session to complete.

Please note: although nuts are not incorporated into the recipes, we cannot guarantee that the ingredients have been sourced from a nut free factory.
