Year 6 River Studies Trip to the River Piddle

We are very excited to let you know about our *Amazing Amazon* topic hook, which will take place in the first week of term in September.

We would like to take the Year 6 children on a trip to study a river and its features. The trip will be to the River Piddle in Wareham, where children will undertake field studies and practical activities on how rivers are formed. We will be travelling by school mini-bus.

The dates for the trips are as follows:

6M – Thursday 7th September morning 6N – Thursday 7th September afternoon

In order to be prepared for the trip, please ensure that your child brings a waterproof coat, wellington boots or shoes suitable to wear in the water (and waterproof trousers if you have them).

Could we also ask that children come to school dressed appropriately for the weather, they do not need to wear school uniform but will need warm clothes and a coat if it is cold and cooler clothes (including a hat) if it is warm. Please ensure that sun cream is applied before your child comes to school, or ensure that they bring a bottle of sun cream with them to apply themselves as staff are unable to apply sun cream. If your child requires travel sickness medication, please ensure they take it before they come in to school, as we are unable to administer this.

The trip will provide an exciting start to Year 6 and it will really help with your child's understanding of our topic. I am sure the children will thoroughly enjoy the trip.
